Introduction:

Our school is committed to providing a safe, respectful and inclusive environment where every student can thrive. This Student Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for student behaviour to ensure a positive learning experience for all.

1. Respect for Others:

- **Treat Everyone with Respect:** Show kindness, courtesy and consideration to all members of the school community, including peers, teachers, staff and visitors. Do not talk or walk during the lessons unless asked by the teacher.
- **No Bullying or Harassment:** Bullying, harassment or any form of discrimination is strictly prohibited. This includes physical, verbal and cyberbully.
- **Respect Differences:** Embrace and respect the diverse backgrounds, cultures and perspectives of others.

2. Academic Integrity:

- **Honesty in Academic Work:** Complete all assignments, tests and projects with honesty. Cheating, plagiarism and any form of academic dishonesty are not tolerated.
- **Effort and Participation:** Put forth your best effort in all academic activities and actively participate in class.

3. Responsibility and Accountability:

- **Be Responsible:** Take responsibility for your actions and their consequences. Follow school rules and policies at all times.
- **Punctuality and Attendance:** Attend school regularly and arrive on time for classes. Inform the school of any absences in advance when possible. Do not skip or walk out from the lessons.
- **Preparedness:** Come to class prepared with the necessary materials and completed assignments.

4. Safe and Healthy Environment:

- **No Violence or Aggression:** Physical violence, threats, and aggressive behavior are not acceptable. Think before you act. Treat the others as you want to be treated.
- **Substance-Free:** The use, possession or distribution of alcohol, drugs or tobacco on school grounds is strictly prohibited.
- **Health and Safety:** Follow all health and safety guidelines, including those related to hygiene, emergency procedures and the use of school facilities.

5. Respect for Property:

- **Care for School Property:** Treat school property and the belongings of others with care and respect. Vandalism and theft are serious offenses.
- **Digital Citizenship:** Use school technology and internet resources responsibly. Follow the school's acceptable use policy for digital devices and online behaviour.

6. Positive Communication:

- **Appropriate Language:** Use language that is respectful and appropriate for a school setting. Avoid profanity, offensive, or hurtful language.
- **Conflict Resolution:** Resolve conflicts peacefully and seek help from teachers or counselor when needed.

7. Dress Code:

- **Dress Appropriately:** Follow the school's dress code policy, which promotes a respectful and distraction-free learning environment.

8. Participation in School Community:

- Engagement: Participate in school activities, clubs, and events in a positive and respectful manner.
- Leadership and Role Modelling: Be a positive role model for peers by demonstrating good behaviour and leadership.
